(AR Pt 1 pg19)</p> <p>Please clarify observer coverage as information provided in AR Part 1 and Part 2 are different</p> <p>SPC advice observer coverage (SC10-2014/ST- IP03) = 4%</p> <p>still unclear what level of ROP coverage was achieved in 2013</p> <p><b>Secretariat update:</b> <b>NO ISSUE DETECTED</b>   <i>Issue Resolved</i></p>	<p>On 23 September, SPC advise CK that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- According to the information provided, the coverage of the observer data collected on CK vessels in 2013 represents 6.2% (based on trips) and 13% (based on logbook days at sea), both of which are above the required coverage for the longline fishery of 5%.</li> <li>- According to the regional logbook data, most of the trips undertaken by CK-flagged vessels in 2013 occurred in the CK EEZ, so would not be considered in the calculation of coverage for ROP data in any event.</li> </ul> <p><b>Secretariat note: based on the additional information provided from SPC, the required observer coverage has been met</b></p>
