Kindly refer to the 14th Regular Session of the Commission agreed to grant a renewal of the Cooperating Non-Member (CNM) status for Thailand for one year with the participatory right limited to the provision of carrier and bunker vessels.

As a CNM, Thailand takes pride in cooperating with the Commission and pledges its commitment to make financial contribution as agreed upon by the Commission in the regular meeting. In addition, we pledge our full commitment in implementation of conservation and management measures adopted by the Commission. Although Thailand reaffirms its position to accept high seas boarding and inspection, it automatically opts out from such commitment due to no fishing.
