Thank you very much for your participation and comments at the recent TCC forum, this was much appreciated.

As noted at TCC, our next steps in the process will be to seek further feedback on the latest draft, with one short virtual workshop prior to the Commission meeting.

Given there was not much time before TCC to comment on the latest draft, we would like to seek feedback from members on the revised draft documents (attached) by 1 November. We would encourage working group participants to reply all with their feedback, to ensure that this is visible to others.

We will send out a revised draft as soon as possible after this date, and would like to hold a short (2-3 hour) virtual workshop during the week of 15 November.
