Dear EREM Participants

In my communique of 15 February 2022 (WCPFC Circular 2022/06), I identified a meeting of the EREM WG to be held over two half days during the week of the 18th of July 2022.

You'll recall, that there are two key priorities for the WG in 2022, including to 'consider and provide advice on outputs from the EREM WG including those related to existing obligations, data gaps and the prioritisation of ER and EM'.

You'll also recall that I have committed to developing a discussion paper (strawman) outlining my thoughts on how the electronic monitoring program integrates with the existing WCPFC management framework, in particular the regional observer scheme.

Given the above, I am proposing that the July meeting of the EREMWG focus on the framework discussion paper and the priorities for the EM. It is my hope that the EREM can reach consensus and inprinciple support on these components to enable them to be presented to the TCC session in September.

Below sets out the proposed dates, format and agenda for the meeting. If you could please consider the dates and the proposed agenda, and provide any comments, by the 8 June 2022. This will enable the Secretariat and I to finalise the meeting logistics, including the circulation of the discussion paper and other papers for the meeting.

On the draft SSPs for the WCPFC EMP, to thank all EREM participants who have submitted comments in response to WCPFC Circular 2022-09 dated 7 March 2022. I have received comments from 10 groups of participants to date, and I have provided an extension to one group of participants. I expect their comments in the coming weeks. To avoid confusion and support version control, I am delaying circulation of the next draft until after those comments are received.

In the spirit of transparency and collaboration, I will upload the combined all comments document to this site as a **locked** file. In doing so, this version will become a reference document and enable us all to see the range of comments and thoughts across the group. This will also enable us to see where there is synergy and/or areas where we will need to work more fulsomely to find common ground.

I do not intend to discuss the draft SSP's in July – rather I would like to focus on the framework as I see it as supporting our collective understanding on how the EM program can fit within the WCPFC management framework and, if there is consensus, that this will support the further development of the CMM and associated SSPs.

Finally, as a reminder the central storage location for all ERandEM WG documents is through the https://www.wcpfc.int/ERandEM-IWG site, including circulars, email etc. In addition, I've asked the Secretariat to setup an Online Discussion Forum for the ERandEM WG to support the intersessional work including assisting members to engage with other participants as we move forward.
